Pilot Projects

The Zirloli 97"ws. P47 fire damaged restoration is nearly done.

After applying panel lines with 1/16" chart tape, the plane was primed and painted with Aluminum epoxy paint. The chart tape was removed before the final coat of paint.

After letting the paint cure for two weeks, I did random and varied panel shading by lightly sanding the panels at different angles and pressure applied. This gave it an authentic look of aluminum panels.
