### **SCRC Pilot Projects**

John Underwood and I are teaming up to build an ESM Hawker Hurricane. This 82" wingspan ARF will be powered by a Moki 2.10 glow engine. Since the plane has a big thick airfoil, plenty power is needed. A gas engine would stick out too much from the narrow cowl





and kill the looks of this classic fighter. The plane will have Sierra retracts and Futaba 2.4 radio. Hitec 645 mg servos will be used on control surfaces. Hope to have it done and be at this Sunday's meeting. See you there! Paul
